	What does it look like?		Release of responsibility
Modelled Writing	Teacher is modelling the writing process. Teacher is explicitly teaching.	Students are listening and viewing the teaching.	I do
Shared Writing	Teacher is sharing the writing with input from students. Teacher is co-constructing the writing.	Students are contributing ideas, listening and viewing the teaching.	We do
Guided Writing	Teacher is guiding the writing based on the needs or next steps of the students. Teacher might model writing explicitly, or create shared writing.	Students are making their own ideas, seeking feedback, clarifying, contributing and following the teachers guidance.	I do / We do
Independent Writing	Teacher might check in to see progress or make suggestions.	Students are writing independently with full control of the session.	You do together You do alone
