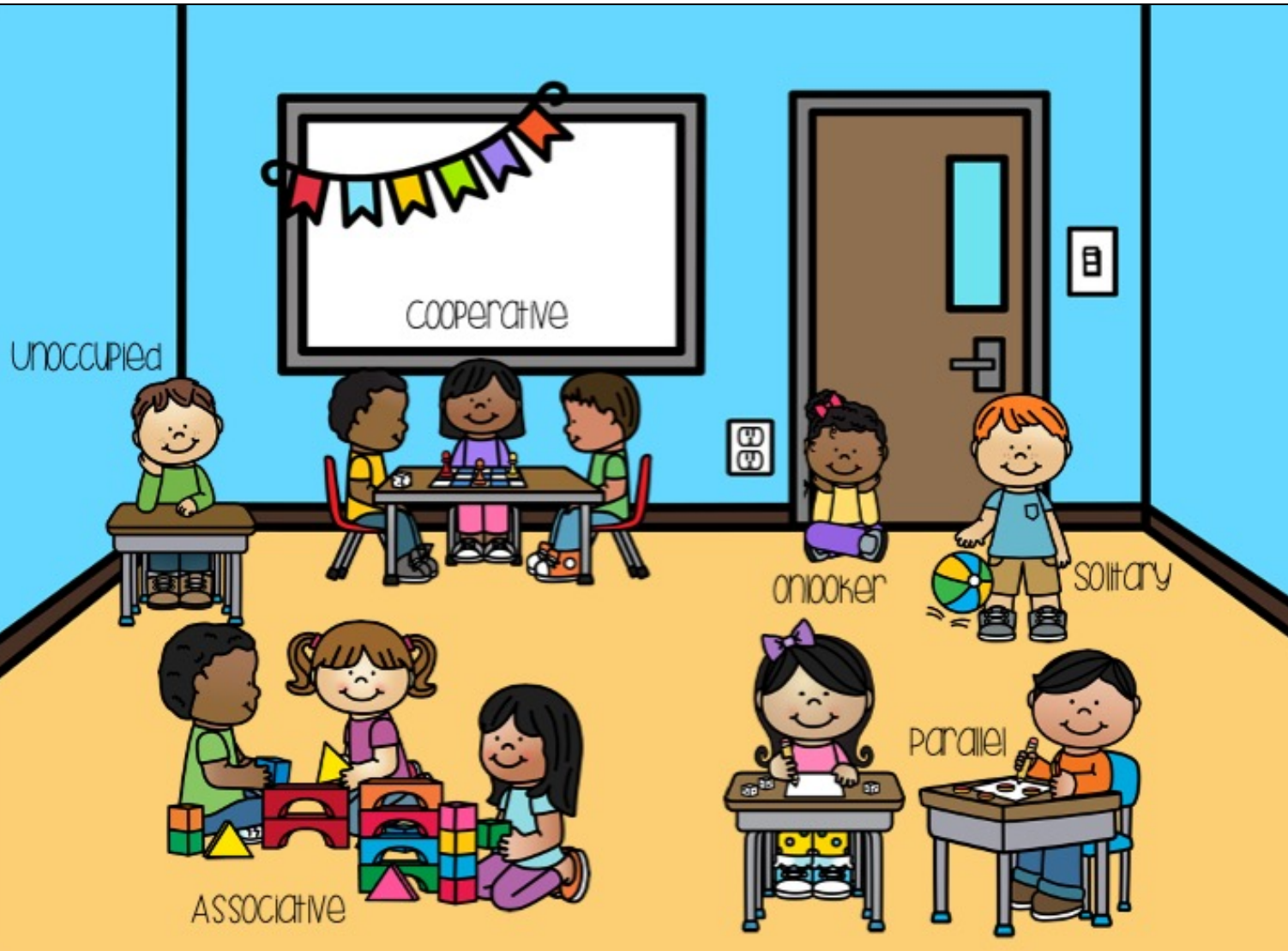


TYPES OF PLAY



UNOCCUPIED
When children are unoccupied with any play

SOLITARY
When children play on their own.

ONLOOKER
When children watch others play. There is no effort to join the play.

PARALLEL
When children play side by side with other children without any interaction. They might pay attention to each other, but have separate play

ASSOCIATIVE
When children interact with each others play but there is not much cooperation happening.

COOPERATIVE PLAY
When children play with others and have interest in both the play and the children.
